Before VolunteerSpot



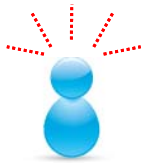
Cookie Coordinator gets the booth schedule and invites Scout Parents to sign up via email, Yahoo!Group or clipboard signup sheet



Scout Parents REPLY ALL or CALL IN their interest and when they are available



Cookie Coordinator juggles the schedule back and forth until it's full – making more calls, sending more emails, and making Excel spread sheets

Checklist:

Successful Cookie Booths

- ✓ **Safety First** – Ensure supervision by the SafetyWise number of adults. Stay near the booth at all times.
- ✓ **Set Expectations** – Talk with Scouts ahead of time about how to act and what to expect. Practice selling by role-playing. Wear uniforms.
- ✓ **Set a Goal** – Display a Troop Goal Thermometer tracking cookie sales.
- ✓ **Bring Needed Supplies** – Table, table covering, chairs, posters, inventory, bags, etc.
- ✓ **Know your Cookies** – Practice cookie facts and provide samples.
- ✓ **Ask Everyone** – Asking is the best way to get people to purchase. Try this great opening line: *What's your Favorite Girl Scout Cookie?*
- ✓ **Best Face Forward** – Smile and be courteous to everyone, even those who don't buy. Never eat or drink at the cookie booth.
- ✓ **Cash Smarts** – Keep the cash box guarded at all times. Bring lots of change. Print an aid to help quickly total sales and make change.
- ✓ **Overcome Objections** – If someone is on a diet, ask them to consider donating a box to your Troop's charity (e.g. Operation Cookie, sending cookies to soldiers overseas).
- ✓ **Say Thank You** – Sincerely thank each customer. Thank the merchant as you leave and follow-up with a card or poster from the Troop.
- ✓ **Leave No Evidence** – Clean up and leave the area even better than before you arrived
